## **Standard Post-Op Drops**

- No driving, operating machinery or appliances or making any important decisions for 24 hours
- Take all your eye drops to your appointment tomorrow
- You may resume your normal activities tomorrow
- Do Not Rub your eye
- Wear shield until rechecked tomorrow. You may remove and instill eye drops as directed but replace immediately. Wear the shield at bedtime for one week
- You may take a bath or shower but no soap or water in the eye for one week
- No bending, lifting or strenuous activity for one week
- No swimming pools, hot tubs, or spas for two weeks
- You may resume your normal diet, routine medications, and prescription eye drops today, unless otherwise instructed

Start the drops below the day of surgery – one drop to the operative eye. Please wash your hands before instilling the eye drops.

Prednisolone (pink or white cap) - every 2 hours while awake the first day
Then 4 times a day for 1 week,

3 times a day for 1 week,

2 times a day for 1 week,

1 time a day for 1 week,

then stop.

Ketorolac (gray cap) - 2 times today
Then 2 times a day for 4 weeks
